

- **Recipient Participation functionality**
  - Ability for Internal Users to send invitations allowing External Users to create accounts within Mail Express to facilitate anytime file transfer.
  - Ability for Internal Users to include reply to links in any email sent. This provides the recipient with an easy way to send files back to the Internal User.
  - New report giving the administrator visibility into all invitation and reply links sent out by Mail Express users
- **Support for External Databases**
  - Installation now allows administrator to specify an external database (either new or existing) for the Mail Express Server to use.
  - Ability to perform various database-related tasks via the Mail Express Server Database Utility
- **Support for 64-bit Office 2010**
  - Mail Express Outlook Add-in now supports 64-bit Outlook 2010
- **File Management page**
  - Allows administrator to view and delete individual files on the Mail Express server
- **Enhanced Package Management page**
  - Provides ability to immediately expire any active package
  - Allows administrator to view all activity (creation information, download history) associated with a package
  - Allows administrator to view all activity related to invitation or reply links sent by Mail Express users
- **Support for 25000 users per user type**
  - Increased maximum number of users per user type (Internal, Drop-off, Administrator) from 10000 to 25000
- **Document Mapping Tool**
  - Command line tool that allows an administrator to easily match up Mail Express packages with the files on the Mail Express server
- **Support for ports other than 443**
  - Server configuration performed via modification of server.xml file in Mail Express installation directory
  - Outlook Add-in allow for port specification during installation and in General Configuration options
